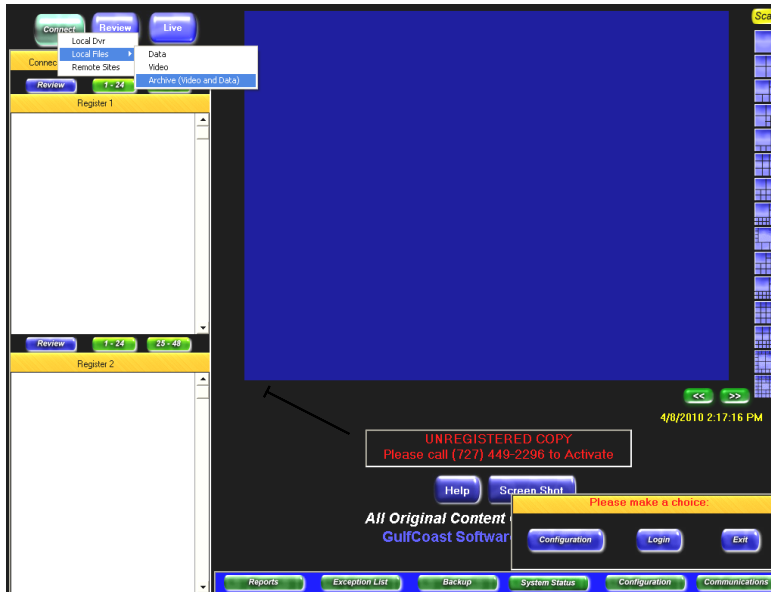


## Using Champlain Farms Transearch/ Storekeeper video playback software

Placing disk into drive should automatically launch the windows installer. This program has Power Point and Office Light that are only necessary for the user manual and do not need to be installed in order to view video. (If you want to access the user manual, and you have these programs or newer versions, there is no need to install them.) After choosing the destination on your hard drive for the Transearch Lite or Storekeeper program, continue with the install wizard and then open the Transearch Lite or Storekeeper program.



There will be a series of buttons at the bottom of the screen. Click on the button Configuration, then click on Login.

The Login ID is “video”  
The password is  
“southerndigital” (one word  
all lower case).

Click on the green or blue Connect button.



Click on “Local files” and archive (video and data). A Windows Explorer window should open; find the CD drive and open the folder. Open the New Backup.gca file to populate the video player.

Click on the search video button near the top left or search data if you are looking for register transactions associated with the video. The date on the disc should appear in the white box below click on this and the times in 5 min increments should pop up. The camera/audio options button will allow you to add or remove cameras.

The play back controls are to the bottom left of the screen (play, pause, stop, frame by frame and speed) and work like a VCR. At any time you can pause and right click on an image to save it as a still in JPEG format or use the advanced save video function to save in a windows friendly AVI video format.
